Welcome Letter

To all Handlers and Guests,

The Golden Retriever Club of America and the Flat-Coated Retriever Society of America in conjunction with the Garden State Golden Retriever Club and the Mid-Atlantic Flat-Coated Retriever Club welcome you to the Working Certificate and Working Certificate Excellent tests open to all retrievers. We trust everyone will enjoy the event.

The success of any GRCA WC/WCX test depends on the generosity and untiring work of many people. Please join us in thanking the NJ DEP for the generous use of these grounds. We are also indebted to our judges, gunners, game steward, marshals, and workers who have given their time and enthusiasm to make this event possible. Finally, many thanks to the numerous volunteers.

We ask for your cooperation in the smooth running of this event. To that end, please:

- Entry is limited to 40 dogs total combined between both the WC and the WCX
- No cross entries of the same dog in more than one stake allowed.
- PLEASE stay on the roads. Do not drive into fields or any of the grounds in use unless directed to do so by the marshal. Stay out of all roped off or blocked areas. DO NOT DRIVE AROUND BARRIERS.
- Arrive at your stake on time. We will do our best to run all stakes as closely as possible to the order of the draw. When in doubt, check with the marshals to see where you should be.
- Take all trash with you and pick up after your dog. Leave the grounds as nice as or nicer than you found them.
- No bitches in season are allowed on the test grounds.
- Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on the grounds.

Your entry acknowledges that there will be an inherent risk in attending the test. By entering or attending this test you are assuming that risk and agree to not hold the GSGRC and MAFCRC, its officers, and volunteers responsible. Ultimately, you are responsible for your own personal safety and the GSGRC and MAFCRC will not be held accountable. Please follow the directions of committee members and marshals to ensure your safety and enjoyment of the test. Anyone who directly disobeys or disregards any direction given will be asked to leave to test grounds, will be disqualified from the test, and no refunds will be provided.

PLEASE NOTE:

Mechanical throwers (wingers) may be used in the WCX.

This is not the pedigree. It MUST be a REGISTRATION (As per GRCA).

FOR RETRIEVER BREEDS, OTHER THAN GOLDEN RETRIEVERS:

- The test will be run under GRCA Rules (see link above)
- It is the responsibility of the handler to supply the necessary paperwork the day of the test.
- It is the responsibility of the handler to submit their paperwork to their breed club after the test.
- Please check with your parent club for necessary documents.

Refunds

Scratch policy

After the closing date, refunds will be given for bitches in heat, injuries, illness, or death of a dog or handler provided that the Test Secretary (Mary Stankovics - GSGRC) is notified prior to the starting time of the stake entered and a written request and an original veterinarian's certification is received by the Test Secretary (Mary Stankovics - GSGRC) in person or by e-mail (mstankovics@comcast.net) or via USPS at their listed address no later than one week following the completion of the test. All refunds will be less the \$4.50 Entry Express fee.

Running Order

Running order will be followed as posted by EntryExpress. Accommodations will be made, as needed, to insure that the test runs in a timely fashion.
