A completed Orthopedic Foundation for Animals Application for Thyroid Database form must accompany this submission.

General Instructions: The sample must be properly collected, handled and shipped to an OFA approved laboratory for analysis. Do not send whole or clotted blood. Collect the blood in a plain glass or plastic clot tube (i.e., no anticoagulants). Allow the sample to clot at room temperature (30-45 minutes) and then centrifuge. Remove serum and place in a plain glass or plastic tube. At least 2 mL of serum is needed to run the required tests. Severely hemolyzed or lipemic serum is not acceptable. Label tubes with the owner's name and animal name/identification. If the serum is to be shipped on the day of collection, refrigerate or freeze until shipped. If not shipped on the day of collection, freeze the sample until shipment. The sample packaging date and time requested above is crucial. **The sample must arrive in the laboratory within 48 hours of shipment, or must arrive below 60 F if arriving after 48 hours.** We recommend at least 0.9 kg (1lb) of frozen gel packs in an insulated container (i.e., 1" Styrofoam) to keep the sample cold during shipment. Additional gel packs may be warranted during the hotter summer months. **Inappropriate samples will not be analyzed.**

Shipping containers are available from the laboratory, and orders can be placed by indicating your request in the upper left corner of this submission form or by calling the laboratory. The sender is responsible for postage and/or special delivery charges on packages sent to the laboratory. Adherence to mailing regulations is the responsibility of the sender. Packages sent collect will be refused. For more information regarding specimen shipping, please visit our website at www.animalhealth.msu.edu.

Test results will be sent ONLY to the submitting veterinarian and the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals. Results will not be made available by telephone. Please refer to the reverse side of this form for options regarding test result delivery methods.
